# Applicability

1999 and later model-year vehicles.

# Length of Coverage

For 1999-2013 model-year vehicles, service adjustments are covered for the length of the Basic Warranty except for wheel balancing and wheel alignments, which are limited to *one* repair during the first 12 months or 20,000 miles, whichever occurs first.

For 2014 and later model-year vehicles, service adjustments are covered for the length of the Basic Warranty except for wheel balancing and wheel alignments, which are limited to *one* repair during the first 12 months or 12,000 miles, whichever occurs first.

### What Is Covered

Any service adjustment listed on the following pages that becomes necessary due to a defect in workmanship is warrantable. Service adjustment operations may only be performed one time during the service adjustment warranty period.

A service adjustment is only needed if an item on the vehicle has come from the factory improperly set to specification. Generally, no parts should be involved when making the adjustment to bring the vehicle into proper specification.

Once set, the vehicle is considered by Toyota to be properly adjusted. If the vehicle is found to be "out of specification" at a later date, it would be due to an improper adjustment by the servicing dealer, a defective part, or customer handling for which the customer is responsible.

For 2014 and later model-year vehicles, wheel balancing and wheel alignments are limited to *one* repair during the first 12 months or 12,000 miles, whichever occurs first.

#### What Is Not Covered

Any service adjustment (excluding wheel balancing and alignment) beyond the length of the Basic Warranty is not warranted.

For wheel balancing and alignment, any adjustment beyond the first 12 months or 20,000 miles (for 1999-2013 model year vehicles) or beyond the first 12 months or 12,000 miles (for 2014 and later model years) is not warranted.

# What Is Not Covered (continued)

Any service adjustment which has been previously performed by the same servicing dealer is not warranted.

Any service adjustment which is required as part of the pre-delivery service is not warrantable. Reimbursement for those adjustments found necessary at that time are reimbursed as part of the pre-delivery service allowance. Service adjustments that are part of PDS or owner responsibility are listed below. These adjustment operations are listed in the Toyota Universal Flat Rate Manual for reference only.
